Tasks that RSVP volunteers commonly do in schools

- Small group reading/math like "walk to read"
- One-on-one in classroom or pull-out time
- Work with ELL/ESL children
- Skills reinforcement with flashcards or games
- Listen to children read or explain their work
- Writing review conferences
- After-school or recess learning activities
- Assist with preparation and distribution of materials within classroom
- Support teacher during group instruction to identify student needs
- Extra pair of hands or eyes in the classroom
- Prepare bulletin boards with student work
- "Read Across America" guest readers
